

This is the BBC 4 radio production of Priestley's classic thriller An Inspector Calls, starring Toby Jones and Francis Barber. It is such a gripping tale to listen to with a clever and intricately woven plot that has you sat in anticipation throughout, perfect for those readers who enjoy mystery and suspense with a twist. Boasting an ideal cast with Toby Jones as the mysterious and inexplicable inspector Goole, the story is brought vividly to life in all its electrifying glory. One night as the Birling family are celebrating the engagement of Shelia Birling to Gerald Croft (a marriage that will merge two large, successful businesses), they receive an unexpected call from an Inspector who is investigating the suicide of a young working-class girl. As the shocking and what was misleading

truth is slowly unraveled for all to see, questions soon arise regarding feelings of guilt and responsibility that many characters begin to suffer from. Each character (similarly to a Pirot, Miss Marple or Sherlock Holmes case under the investigation of the police) comes under the spotlight as the protagonist tries to detect the underlying reasons for Eva Smith's death. It is the Inspector who exposes the middle-class, standoffish Birling family headed by industrialist Arthur Birling (played by David Calder), as complicit in the suicide case. Priestley's classic play about morality, honesty and truth sounds just so engaging on the radio and atmospheric from the very first opening scene. Toby Jones, David Calder, Francis Barber and Morven Christie (who plays Sheila Birling) are just spectacular and you will be swept away by the intensity of the drama.
