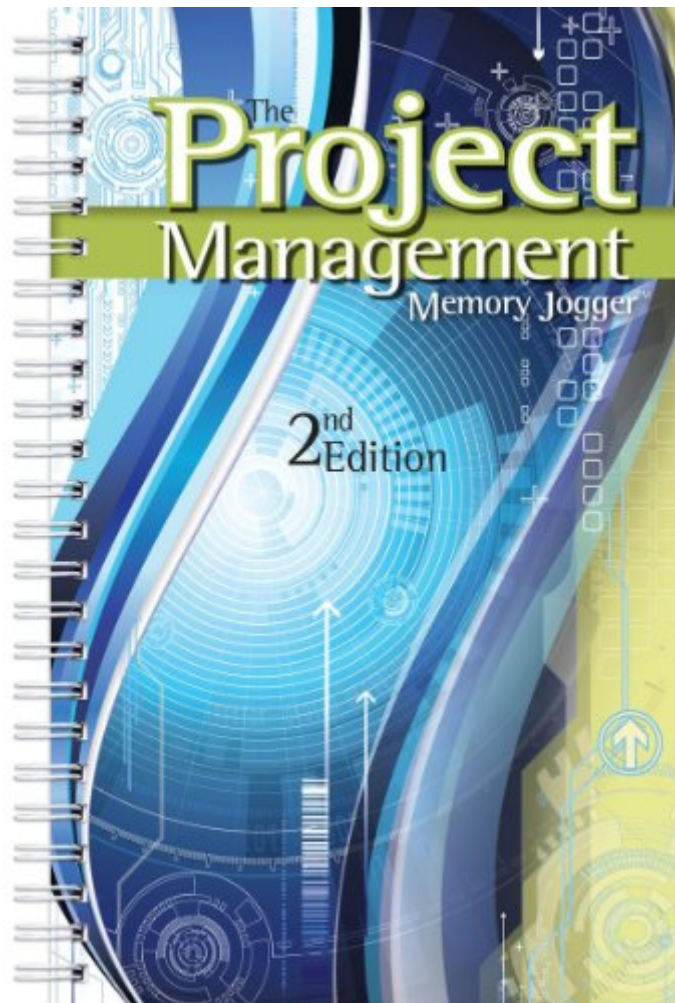

7. Moved the Activity Schedule and Product Life Cycle to the Appendix.
8. Added a Chapter on collaborative decision making tools and analysis for use with project teams for identification of issues, prioritization, and root cause identification (Affinity Diagram, Interrelationship Digraph, Prioritization Matrices).

Whether you work on huge, complex, international projects for one of the Fortune 50 or you are putting together a family reunion, you will find something of value in this little book. But don't let either the size of the book (pocket) or the size of the print (small) fool or intimidate you. The ideas are clear and accessible. These two consultants have written a project management book for our times. Their approach is team-based and collaborative -- particularly useful for those of us who work in organizations that use teams but still think in functional silos -- as well as practical and flexible. Personally, I have always found other project management models to be too complex, too highly delineated, and too quantitative. This approach is logical, fact-based, and flexible enough for me to work the parts that apply and skip the ones that don't. I highly recommend the book as well as the approach. If you want to get the full benefit of their methodology, bring the authors in for in-house training. That way, the kinesthetic and auditory processors in your organization will "get it" even better.

I bought this to view on my Samsung Note II via the android Kindle app. The usefulness of this book is diminished somewhat by lack of pagination in the Kindle App. The book references other pages throughout, but there is no way to identify what page you are on or change to the referenced page. The eBook or Kindle app (or both) need to be programmed to fix this. The "go to page" function exists, it is grayed out and apparently pages are not bookmark or it just doesn't work.

I purchased this book for my Master's Degree class as a requirement. I am very happy with how this book is written for learning how to do a Gantt Chart. I was able to follow along with the course requirements without an issue.
