There are a great many really good jokes in this collection. Quite a few of them could very easily be worked into a number of different types of speeches, lectures or presentations. My only problem is that many of these jokes are not really politically incorrect, which was THE reason I purchased it. Then there are more than a few which were neither politically incorrect or jokes. This book could have been trimmed by about 30% and maybe sold for a few cents less and been a better product. As is the case with the vast majority of joke books I've purchased, there seemed to be a need for filler to make it a respectable length. I'd rather have less book, even if the price stayed the same.
