

Let's get something off my chest right here and now. I rarely allow a single book to change my life, but I let Frank Romano's 1984 work Type Encyclopedia send me on a whole new course. It is the book that single-handedly convinced me I could be an independent typographer, designing my own books and websites rather than putting up the cash for somebody else to do it.
