This series of tapes brings Garcia a few steps closer to all of us. Originally the tapes were to be part of McNally's doctoral dissertation on a Jack Kerouac biography. This is a hard book to rate because of the personal contents and how it's presented. Some readers may rate this higher or perhaps a bit lower--to each his own.
